Letter from Ed Schreiner, President, Master Association

First of all, I want to wish everyone here a Happy (and safe) Holiday season, whatever your persuasion. The early cold weather up north is sure to portend well for us down here in the sunshine.

I thought I'd catch you up on some of the results of the November Board of Governors meeting.

We have been operating for some time with a color chart from Sherwin Williams that we use as a guide for what is acceptable when you want to repaint your house. Sherwin Williams has advised us that the paint in portions of our color chart is no longer available and that there were new colors that were more up-to-date than those we were using. Stop by the office to check out the new chart and, remember, you must get an Architectural Review Form completed and reviewed by the ARC committee prior to beginning your project. The committee meets the first Monday of each month. The forms are available at the office.

The Buildings and Grounds Committee has been working for some time on a new location for our memorial garden, which currently sits by the side entrance to the pool facility. The new location will be on the peninsula near the lake where the old flagpole used to stand. The Board approved the erection of a new flagpole, which will be illuminated by permanent lighting, and the memorial garden will be imbedded in the ground at the peninsula. The goal is to have a place of quiet contemplation, more in keeping with the memories of our loved ones.

I've been asked a few times why we put the "Deed Restricted Community" signs up at our front entrance. The issue we face repeatedly is people moving in who have no understanding that there are restrictions to what can be done with their property in Fountain Lakes. While agents and title reps are supposed to review the covenants with their clients, it is apparent that it doesn't always happen...or, more frequently, buyers don't absorb the importance of what they are being told. The most frequent "misunderstandings" we get here in the office have to do with parking overnight in the street (not allowed), storage of boats or trailers or project cars in the driveway (not allowed), parking commercial vehicles overnight outside and proceeding with a paint project or paving project without architectural review. Having the "Deed Restricted Community" signs up, we hope will prompt the appropriate questions to come up before the sale and reduce the hard feelings that we frequently deal with once the sale is done.

One more important piece of information: We have talked with Lee County and have their agreement that we can put yard waste out at the curb beginning on Friday noon for Monday pickup. Please do not put it in the street or over waste drains as it blocks water runoff if we have rain. Thank you for your cooperation.

I encourage all of you to attend the Board of Governors meetings. It keeps you in tune with where your board is taking the community and is a good way to stay in touch.




