It's that time of year when the pace slows down a little and we bid farewell to our friends who were with us for the season and have left for their other homes. Lee County seemed pleased with their influx of visitors and it appeared that we had our share of the good news in Fountain Lakes as well.

Our recent Board of Governors meeting made some decisions that I'd like to share with you.

1. We renewed our intentions to continue down the path of Covenant Enforcement that was created the year before last in conjunction with the Presidents' Council. We should all be interested in making sure that our community remains an attractive one to anyone coming through the gates. It affects our investment and should be a source of pride for all of us.

2. We approved an upgrade to the software system that runs our gates. The current system is maxed out, obsolete, and can not accommodate the addition of more "clickers". The new system is just the start of what could potentially be an exciting enhancement to how we regulate traffic throughout the community. As a start, the new system will still accommodate the existing clickers, but will also have the capability to accommodate Radio Frequency access, whereby a sticker on your window is scanned by a device on the side of the road that automatically opens the gates on approach. It will also accept key fobs and security proximity cards should we choose to add those devices. If we allow ourselves to dream a little, it could also regulate access to such amenities as the gym, or the billiards room or any other amenity that we choose to regulate. But that's down the road a bit. We need to get the system upgraded first. This will require re-registration to get your clickers into the new database so we will be asking for your help in accomplishing that big task.

3. The Presidents and the Board of Governors are united also in the goal of having the gates closed at all times, opening upon approach during the day and locked down at night. Because of the concern that the mechanical system that opens and closes the gates is old and suspect, we tabled that action until we can explore the cost of updating the opening and closing mechanisms to allow for the wear and tear of constant opening and closing. We hope to have more information at the next board meeting.

4. For pickleball aficionados, we will be lining the courts with both conventional tennis lines and pickleball lines when the courts are resurfaced this summer. The pickleball lines will be of a different color to reduce the confusion on boundaries for the tennis players.

5. We voted to purchase a new billiard table for our billiards room to replace the one that is smaller than official size and to install new felt on the remaining tables. There is tremendous concern for the amount of speeding and stop sign running that is taking place in Fountain Lakes. The board approved the idea of placing speed humps at strategic locations on Fountain Lakes Blvd. It was decided that the first one would be installed at the entrance to The Manors and, based on the results of that placement, others will be considered.

These are the highlights from the meeting. I would encourage you to attend these meetings as it is a view into the operations of the community and we are always receptive to feedback from residents. Each business meeting will be followed by a "Town Hall" format for you to ask questions and raise issues that you are concerned about
