# Pet Safety

Due to two recent incidents in Fountain Lakes, this is a good time to educate Pet Parents on safety while walking a dog, and to remind residents that dogs may not be outside without being on a leash that is strong enough to hold them. In December, two normally docile dogs of the same breed encountered one another while on leashes. One dog attacked the other dog. The injury was so severe that the attacked dog had to have his eye surgically removed. Both dog owners felt terrible. In another incident, a person was bitten by a small dog.

Pet Parents should be aware that on-leash greetings can often create too much tension for dogs to handle. Dogs have the fight or flight response. They typically will try their best to get away. However, if a dog is on-leash, he may feel his flight option has been eliminated. That leaves him with only one option, he becomes a fighter not a lover."

For safety reasons, Pet Parents should disregard anyone who says, "My dog is friendly." Dog walkers should keep a good distance from any approaching dog.

Pet Parents should be aware of the dangers of retractable leashes. Retractable leashes can malfunction over time. The thin cord of the leash can easily break, tear, or fray. The length of the leash allows dogs to be put in dangerous situations. The cord can cut, hurt, or even amputate the walker. Retractable leashes hinder the ability of the owner to control his/her dog.

Pet Parents also should note that in Lee County, it is illegal to have a dog off-leash upon any public street, sidewalk, school grounds, in the area of school vehicles, beaches, parks or on the private property of others without the consent of the owner of such property.

Keeping the above tips in mind will hopefully reduce the risks of injury to yourself, others, or your dog. However, in case of a pet emergency, both Florida Veterinary Referral Center in Estero on Corkscrew Road and Southwest Florida Veterinary Specialists in Bonita Springs on Old 41 are open 24/7.

## No More Assignment of Benefits to Roofing Companies

As of last July 2019 there is no longer Assignment of Benefits (AOB) permitted in Florida. With our roof currently being replaced, a number of people have stopped to talk to me and several people related stories of being scammed by roofing companies after they assigned benefits to them. Thankfully this practise can never happen again.

I also heard many stories of many people having their roof claim turned down by their insurance companies. Our roofer got our roof covered by our insurance, after us being turned down previously by our insurance company. It was also comforting to me that Ashley from our management company Pegasus was our roofer's reference as she has used him many times. He is also doing at least one other roof just down the road, who was pleased to learn that she is also being covered by insurance, after dealing with our roofer, Dylan(239-810-8761)

I have learned that unless the roofer goes up on the roof with the appraiser from the insurance company, to argue your case and site Florida law, you are likely to be turned down. For instance, when the appraiser arrived early for his appointment here last month, he told me the water dripping in onto our floor was just condensation, but when Dylan our roofer arrived five minutes later, and went up in the attic and on the roof with him, the appraisor suddenly decided that it was a valid insurance claim. I would never again deal with a roofing company who does not do the work of coming to meet with the appraiser and advocating on your behalf with the insurance company. They have the knowledge to argue your claim and should be there to support you, and, if first denied they should be there to continue to argue your case. Since we are Canadians and are paying with a low dollar, Dylan saved us about 20,000.00 which we would have had to pay because water was actually coming in on the floor this year. I do know one person who called several companies and was told they do not advocate with the insurance company, so be sure you ask that question before you decide on a roofing company.
