#### HELPFUL HINTS FOR KEEPING WILD HOGS AT BAY

Please note: There is no true way to eliminate wild hogs entirely. Like bobcats, coyotes, and other displaced wildlife, they are part of our environment, often affected by ongoing development. That said, sightings and damage have been minimal over the past year.

If you encounter a hog in your yard, please report it by emailing fountainlakehog@gmail.com with the following details:

- Address where the hog(s) were seen
- Time of day
- · Description of any damage

This information is forwarded to our trapper, who visits the property regularly.

#### **Prevention Tips:**

- Use Motion-Activated Lights & Sprinklers Many residents have had success with these deterrents.
- Keep Your Yard Clear Remove loose debris, underbrush, and anything that could serve as shelter.
- Eliminate Food Sources Hogs are attracted to bird feeders, fruit trees, pet food, and trash.
- Keep Lights On from Dusk to Dawn This has helped deter them in the past.

#### Safety Reminder:

Hogs are generally not aggressive unless confronted. Their movement and feeding patterns are unpredictable, and they tend to run rather than attack.

By staying vigilant and keeping your property uninviting to hogs, we can continue to reduce their presence in our community.
